Maximum 750 characters - average 120 words.

We'd love to learn more about what drives you! Don't worry, we are not asking for a professionally produced video. In fact, we LOVE videos that are clearly just you being YOU. We want to see your passion, your voice, and your energy.

VIDEO INSTRUCTIONS:

You can click the recorder icon within the application to record and upload your video directly. If you are the spontaneous, go-for-it type please feel free to use this option! However, we have found that most of our applicants prefer to prepare before recording.

- 1. <u>Prepare:</u> This does not need to be a professional quality recording. To create an impactful video, we recommend that you take a few moments to gather your thoughts from the prompts below, before recording. Feel free to use reference notes if you find that helpful, but try not to read from a script. Just be yourself!
- 2. <u>Choose Your Setup:</u> Determine where you want to record the video. Create your video in a quiet place. Background noise can hinder the quality of your video and make it difficult to hear or understand you speaking.
- 3. <u>Record Your Video</u> using your phone or computer camera. *Please do not share* pre-recorded promo clips or professionally produced promotional videos. We are not looking for professional video quality.
- 4. Review Your Video. Make sure that your voice can be clearly heard and that your video is at least 1 minute long, but no longer than 2 minutes. Do not add any background music or after-effects to your video.

5. <u>Upload your Video</u> below. Click on the upload icon below and select your video file. Video files must be less than 1 GB.

- 1. Introduce Yourself: Begin by stating your full name and where you are from.
- 2. Describe yourself as a leader and tell us about the potential you see within yourself!
